Partner organizations include: The City of Newport, Downtown Revitalization and Improvement Volunteer Effort, the Iron Mountain Regional Arts Council, the Newport Economic Development Commission, and the Newport Area Chamber of Commerce with financial support from the Ozark Gateway Tourist Council and generous donations by individual artists.

Your Booth Space

The size of your booth at the Delta Visual Arts Show will vary depending on your location. See the location maps for more information on booth size. Each booth will have one table (between 6 and 8 feet long) and two chairs. Artists are expected to bring their own table cloth, easels or display racks, long extension cords if power is needed, power strips if multiple plugs are needed, additional tables and chairs, if needed, and a lot of art!

All booths are assigned by the Blue Bridge Center for the Delta Arts Steering Committee. The decisions of the Committee are final. Booth locations are included at the end of this packet. Please do not request to change booths the day of the show as materials will have already been printed with the booth spaces on them.

Artists are encouraged to produce art at their booths. These demonstrations tend to draw crowds and create more sales. If you are in a building and plan to demonstrate at your booth, please bring drop cloths or other protective materials.

Set up times will remain the same: Friday, February 26th from noon until 6:30 pm or Saturday, February 27th from 7 am until 9 am. We ask that all booths be set up no later than 9:30 am and that all booths stay up until 6 pm. *Please do not take your booth down early. If you leave early then we have failed when we advertise that the show will be open until 6 pm.*

Publicity! Publicity! Publicity!

We will be advertising the show via radio and newspaper advertisements as well as through free media time. However, we've found the best advertising is you! If you go to the Blue Bridge Center for the Delta Arts Facebook page, find the event page for the 8th Annual Delta Visual Arts Show, make sure you invite all your friends and share the event on your own Facebook page, website, etc. that reaches more people than all other media activity combined. So help us get the word out for a great show!

Hospitality Rooms

The Delta Visual Arts Show is pleased to offer Hospitality Rooms for the artists again this year. Coffee and donuts will be provided in the morning and sodas, water, sandwiches and other snacks will be offered for lunch. Cookies and brownies will be provided for afternoon snacks. The Hospitality Rooms are provided free of charge for the artists and anyone who is working with them in their booth. We do ask that the Hospitality Rooms only be used by artists and those who are working with them. There will be food available at several downtown restaurants for the public.

Happy Hour Beverages

The Delta Visual Arts Show plans to offer adult beverages during a Happy Hour period. Each artist who is 21 or over will receive two complimentary drink tickets for their use. Each artist will also be given ten drink tickets that they can distribute from their booths. If an artist would like to decline to distribute tickets, that is an acceptable choice. Artists who distribute tickets can use their own method (i.e. giving tickets to customers, giving tickets to friends, randomly giving out tickets, etc.). Beer and wine will only be given to people who are over 21 and who produce a ticket. The two drink areas will be in the Hazel Street Tent and the Walnut Street Tent.

Artists for 2016 Exhibits

The Delta Visual Arts Show Steering Committee will be visiting the booths throughout the day and making a list of artists that they would like to invite to display their work for six to eight weeks during the 2016 season. Artists chosen to be a Featured Exhibit Artist will be invited to display their work at the Newport Business Resource Center. The exhibit will kick off with an opening reception so the artist can meet the public.

Pay It Forward Donations

The Blue Bridge Center for the Delta Arts will again accept voluntary donations of pieces of art from artists participating in the Delta Visual Arts Show. These works of art will be displayed from February through August and offered for sale at their "retail" value. In October, the Steering Committee will host an Evening with the Arts auction and fundraiser, and the donated art will be sold to the highest bidders. All proceeds from the auction will be used toward next year's Delta Visual Arts Show.

Last year, artists donated 140 pieces of art and over \$10,000 was sold and put toward this year's show. This is the main reason we are able to offer the show free again this year. No artist will be required to donate, but any and all donations are appreciated. Toward the end of the show, your building manager will make the rounds and visit with you about possible donations.

Art at the Library

The W.A. Billingsley Jackson County Library will be hosting two different exhibits during the 8th Annual Art Show. The first will be the Arkansas Arts Center Children’s Contest Winner’s Traveling Exhibit, with fantastic artwork from children who live in Arkansas. The second is an amazing exhibit of quilts made by Mika Hyman from the rodeo bandannas of the late Rob McDonald. The exhibits will be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

“This is the Delta” Art Contest

The 8th Annual Delta Visual Arts Show will again feature a “This is the Delta” art contest for participating artists. To enter the contest an artist must have a booth at the Delta Visual Arts Show. Pieces entered into the show must illustrate an aspect of Delta life, which can include, but not be limited to, agriculture, architecture, people, music, places, customs and recreation. Entries will be accepted in the following categories: **Painting, Drawing, Sculpture, Photography, Pottery, Mixed Media, Jewelry and Woodworking**. Please indicate the category into which your entry is being entered. All contact information must be securely fastened on the back of every piece.

Pieces must have been completed in the last three (3) years and cannot have been entered into a previous “This is the Delta” contest. Pieces can be of any size and framed or unframed, however, they must be able to be displayed on a table, easel or free standing. The following prizes will be awarded in each category: **First (\$75), Second (\$50) and Third (\$25)**. In addition, there will be a **Best of Show award of \$125** for one entry.

All pieces must be received prior to **9:30 a.m. on February 27th** to be entered into the contest. Early entries will be accepted at the Newport Business Resource Center, 201 Hazel Street, Newport, Arkansas. Entries the day before the show or the day of the show will be accepted at the John Minor Building, corner of Walnut and Front streets, Newport, Arkansas. The contest winners will be announced at noon on the day of the show. Entries must remain on display in the John Minor Building until 5 pm the day of the show.

“Children of the Delta” Art Contest

The Delta Visual Arts Show will again feature the Children of the Delta Art Contest for young people ages Pre-Kindergarten through 6th Grade. Entries are due no later than **5 pm on February 19, 2016** and may be delivered to the Newport Business Resource Center, 201 Hazel Street, Newport, AR 72112 in person or by mail. Awards will be given in four categories: Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten, First and Second Grades, Third and Fourth Grades and Fifth and Sixth Grades. There will be a 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place and Honorable Mention award in each category. Artwork must have been completed in the last twelve (12) months and must not have been entered in a previous Children of the Delta Art Contest. Only one entry is allowed per person. All contact information must be securely fastened on the back of every piece.

All types of 2D visual work are accepted, including painting, drawing, photography or any other work that can be hung with clips on a line. No framed art is accepted. No computer generated art, nudes, depictions of illegal substances, depictions of gang activity or graphic violence are

allowed. Canvas entries will be accepted if wire hangers have been attached across the back (no saw tooth hangers please). The minimum size for entries is 4" by 6" and the maximum size is 11" by 14".

Awards will be announced at the Delta Visual Arts Show on **Saturday, February 27th by 10 a.m.** Work must remain on display until 3 p.m. the day of the show. All work must be retrieved either the day of the show or from the Newport Business Resource Center no later than 5 p.m. on March 4, 2016. The Blue Bridge Center for the Delta Arts is not responsible for work that has not been retrieved by the March 4th deadline.

Art Bucks Door Prizes

Door prizes will be given during the Delta Visual Arts Show. To qualify for a door prize a person must register at one of the "new" venues; the Brick Terrace Gardens, the Episcopal Parish Hall or the Seeds of Faith Fellowship Hall. Prizes will be drawn each hour from noon until 5 p.m. The door prizes will be in the form of Art Bucks (Art Bucks are "fake" show money) that can only be spent toward art at this year's show. After the show artists can bring their Art Bucks to the Newport Business Resource Center and receive a check for that amount from the Delta Visual Arts Show. If an artist does not make it to the Newport Business Resource Center after the show, they can mail in the Art Bucks they received with a description of what they sold and receive a check in the mail.

Sales and Use Tax

Artists at the Delta Visual Arts Show are responsible for paying State and Local Sales and Use Tax on their sales. Forms and envelopes will be provided at your booth and you will be responsible for submitting the form and the payment within 30 days of the show. If you currently have an Arkansas Sales Tax number and submit sales and use tax to the State of Arkansas monthly, then you can enter the income on your regular form. If you do not have a sales tax number then you are required to remit the sales tax on the provided form. The Arkansas Department of Finance Administration prefers that you leave the form and a check for the payment made to the Arkansas Department of Finance Administration with the Delta Visual Arts Show, however, ultimately you are responsible for submitting the payment to the state. Any questions relating to Arkansas Sales and Use Tax may be referred to the Arkansas Department of Finance Administration at (501) 682-7104. The City of Newport (Code 34-01) tax rate is 1.5%, the Jackson County (Code 34-00) tax rate is 2.25% and the State of Arkansas tax rate is 6.50%. So the total tax rate for artists is 10.25%. You may absorb this amount in your overall price or you may choose to add 10.25% to each sale. The way you handle the tax issue with your customer is completely up to you.

Art Show Venues

The Delta Visual Arts Show is held in a number of venues in downtown Newport, Arkansas. Check in on Friday will be at the Newport Business Resource Center, 201 Hazel Street, Newport, Arkansas and check in on Saturday will be at your designated location. We reserve the right to send an additional email with location changes nearer show time.

Please note the following venues and the rules and regulations relating to each venue:

Brick Terrace Garden – This is a new venue this year and will replace the small tent. Booths will be set up on both sides of the building with an aisle down the middle. The booths will be approximately 7 feet by 12 feet. There will be 12 booths in this venue.

Episcopal Church Parish House– This is a new venue this year and will replace some of the tent booths. The booths will be approximately 8 feet by 8 feet. There will be 11 booths in this venue.

First United Methodist Church – We have no changes in this venue this year. Booth spaces are approximately 8 feet by 8 feet. There will be 12 booths in this venue.

Hazel Street Tent – The tent will be like the tents from previous years – a long tent with a roof, sides and heaters that cover half a block of street. Electricity is available but vendors must bring their own extension cords. Booth spaces are approximately 10 feet by 10 feet. There will be 34 booths in this venue.

Iron Mountain Train Depot – We have no changes in this venue this year. Booth spaces are approximately 9 feet by 9 feet. There will be 19 booths in this venue.

Newport Business Resource Center – We have no changes in this venue this year. Booths in this venue are approximately 9 feet by 9 feet. There will be 21 booths in this venue.

Old Post Office – We have no changes in this venue for this year. Booths in this venue will be approximately 9 feet by 9 feet. There will be 17 booths in this venue.

Seeds of Faith Church – This venue is new this year and will replace some of the booths in the large tent. Booths will be set up in the fellowship area. Please note that we ask that artwork that is displayed in this venue contain no nudity or profanity. If you are assigned to this venue and that is an issue with art work you plan to display, please let us know as soon as possible so that we can reassign you to another location. Also note that alcoholic beverages will not be allowed in this location. Booths will be approximately 7 feet by 11 feet. There will be 12 booths in this venue.

Walnut Street Tent – The tent will be like the tents from previous years – a long tent with a roof, sides and heaters that cover half a block of street. Electricity is available but vendors must bring their own extension cords. Booth spaces are approximately 10 feet by 10 feet. There will be 34 booths in this venue.

Adult Workshops – Adult workshops will be held in the Newport Business Resource Center (upstairs) and in the W.A. Billingsley Jackson County Library.

Children’s Workshops – Children’s workshops and the children’s art contest will be held in the First United Methodist Church Sunday School Annex.

This is the Delta Art Contest – The contest will be held in the John Minor Building as it has in the past.
